Tuition and boarding fees are based on an annual charge and are billed on February 1. If all tuition and boarding fees are paid in full by April 21, a discount of 3% will be applied.

Note: The fees outlined above include the cost of all core activities, including compulsory camps and travel costs. For boarding students, there is an additional GST charge on food of \$594 for the year.

FEE PAYMENTS IN ADVANCE

For day school students, a Fee in Advance payment of \$1500 must be paid in the term before commencing at ACK. For boarding students, a Fee in Advance payment of \$6300 must be paid in the term before commencing at ACK.

This Fee in Advance will be required in each year of attendance excepting year 12. This Fee in Advance payment will be credited towards the following year's fees.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES THAT MAY APPLY

- Elective subject material charges – There may be additional charges for materials needed for individual projects during the year
- Laptop fee – an annual charge for laptop
- Locker fee – a one-off fee that applies to all new students
- Photocopying/textbook/subscription fee – may apply in lieu of buying textbooks. Refer to appropriate booklist
- Misplaced library book – replacement cost of book not returned at the end of each term (reversed if book is returned)
- Damage to school/boarding houses/laptop – charges applied after parents have been notified
- Instrumental music lessons – applies only to students undertaking this co-curricular activity
- Dance lessons – applies only to students undertaking this co-curricular activity
- Printing, photocopying, data – an allowance is applied to each student on a monthly basis via his or her student ID card. Additional access to these services will require payment directly to the school administration office
- Electrical tagging fee – for testing of each student's electrical devices in the boarding houses

As far as is practicable, the above fees and charges cover the supply of compulsory excursions/'incursions'/activities and associated travel, and most classroom requirements. Parents are liable to cover the costs of uniforms and booklist items.

Charges relating to non-compulsory activities may be made throughout the year. These will be made based on participation in these activities and *will not* be applied to the school fee account, e.g. Year 12 Graduation, French Exchange, various immersions and interschool events. These activities require payment in advance on TryBooking.

Where a student is enrolled in VET/VCAL subjects conducted by an external institution, the College will no longer be charging families.

Families using our bus service will be billed separately to school fees.

Please note: a one-term fee in lieu of notice will be applied if students leave the College without notice.
